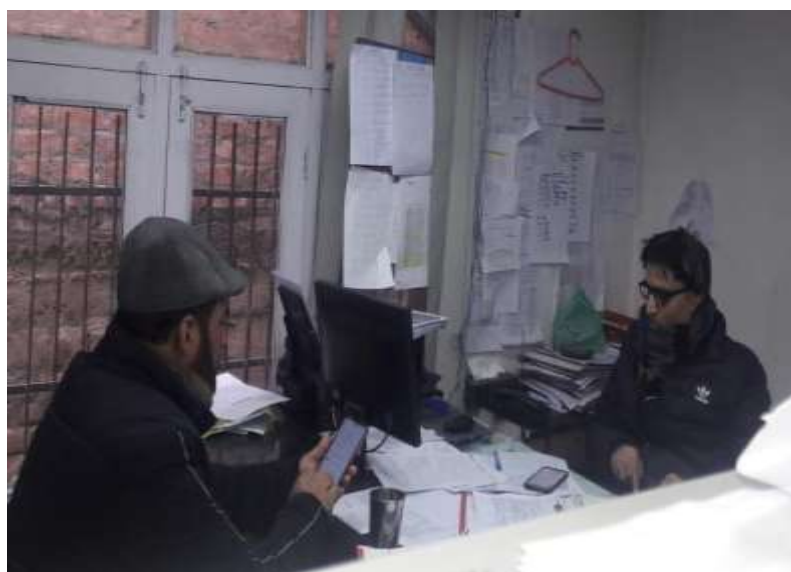

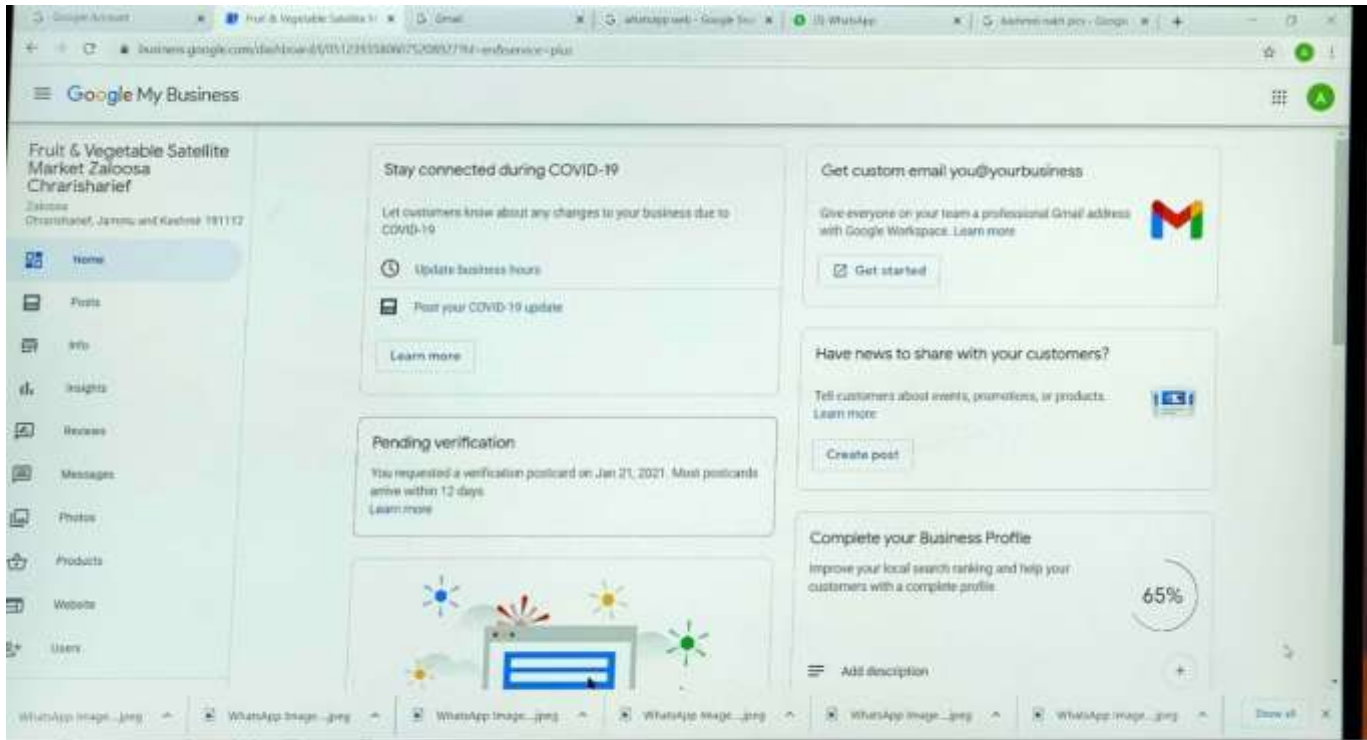

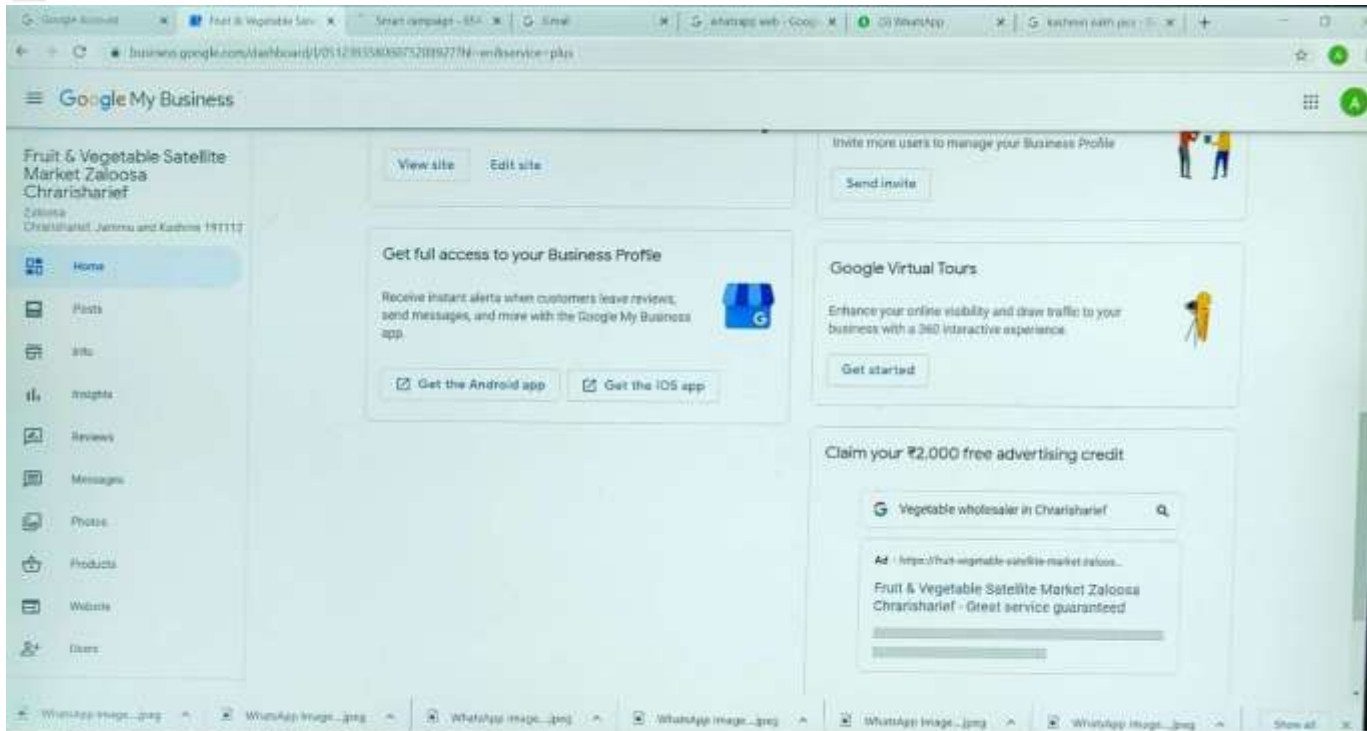

## AGMO Sumbal

To day on 21 .01 .2021 AGMO SUMBAL alongwith staff had a detailed meeting with progressive fruit growers/traders of Asham village ,block Sumbal,where in near about one dozen progressive fruit growers of the area participated.

AGMO sumbal gave a detailed overview of the ongoing schemes and programmes especially Operation Greens and ODOP in the meeting .

The fruit growers appreciated the efforts of the department especially the fruit markets in providing relief to the distressed growers during the pandemic.

In the meeting fruit growers expressed deep concern over the last years damage of Apple crop due to the substandard supply of fertilisers and pesticides in the Markets.

During the meeting ,fruit growers demanded providing of high density , quality Plant Material to increase the competitiveness in the market.

They also demanded introduction of Market Intervention scheme for purchasing of C grade apple to phase out low quality produce .

A number of queries with reference to Operation Greens especially issue of weight slips and online payment of transport receipts was highlighted by the participants.

The NAFED representative was called over the phone to answer the queries.

The participants also highlighted that a number of unemployed youth are aggregating fruit during the procurement season , putting in the own capital also providing employment to people but they are not included in the ambit of Operation Greens and requested to take up the matter with the higher authorities.

The participants were anxious to visit the centers of excellence for learning the new technological interventions taking place in horticulture industry,new plant material,and requested the visiting officers/ officials to help in arranging a visit to Central Institute of Temperate Horticulture to get a firsthand knowledge.

AGMO sumbal assured the growers that their genuine demands would be conveyed to higher authorities .





**One District One Product (ODOP) approach is to reap the benefit of scale in terms of procurement of inputs, availing common services and marketing of products. ODOP for the scheme will provide the framework for value chain development and alignment of support infrastructure.**  
**SPICES AND PICKLES IS THE PRODUCT FOR DISTRICT KULGAM**

**Programme Components**

- Support to individual and groups of micro enterprises;
- Branding and Marketing support;
- Support for strengthening of institutions;
- Setting up robust project management framework.

**SUPPORT**

- Individual micro food processing units would be provided credit-linked capital subsidy @35% of the eligible project cost with a maximum ceiling of Rs. 10.0 lakh per unit .
- Subsidy will be credited to the beneficiary account after 3 years.
- Beneficiary contribution should be minimum of 10% of the project cost with balance being loan from Bank.
- Seed capital @ Rs.40,000/- per member of SHG for working capital and purchase of small tools would be provided under the scheme.
- Support to individual SHG member as a single unit of food processing industry with credit linked grant @35% with maximum amount being Rs.10 lakh.

**Credit Linkage**

- The main expenditure under the Scheme is credit linked grant @35% for the for micro food processing enterprises subject to a maximum of Rs.10 lakh.

• At the national level, a Nodal bank would be appointed for disbursement of subsidy to the banks and liaison with the banks.

**Convergence Framework**

Food Processing Enterprises being supported under the Scheme would be eligible for benefits under the following Government Schemes:

- National Rural Livelihood Mission
- Village Entrepreneurship Programme (SVEP)
- Interest Subvention Scheme for incremental credit to MSMEs 2018 - 2% interest subvention on outstanding balance;
- Credit Guarantee Trust Fund for Micro & Small Enterprises (CGTMSE) for collateral free loan up to Rs 2 crore;
- PM MUDRA Yojana for loan up to Rs.10 lakh;
- A Scheme for Promotion of Innovation, Rural Industry and Entrepreneurship (ASPIRE);
- Scheme for Fund for Regeneration of Rural Industry (SFRIRI);
- Public Procurement Policy for MSEs;
- Benefits available under various other Schemes of MoFPI such as Backward & Forward Linkages, Agricultural Production Cluster, Cold Chain etc. would be used to provide support to clusters/groups.
- Support from PMKVY and NRLM for skill
